

Complying Fund Letter

Everything an employer needs to know about Cbus Super



To the employer

This document contains payment details and other important fund information an employer needs to refer to when an employee chooses Cbus Super to receive their Superannuation Guarantee (SG) contributions.

Letter of Compliance

Cbus Super is:

- a resident regulated superannuation fund within the meaning of the *Superannuation Industry (Supervision) Act 1993 (SIS)*
- not currently or ever has been under direction not to accept any contributions from an employer sponsor (under s.63 of SIS)
- able to accept super contributions from employers on behalf of their employees
- an authorised MySuper provider and meets the insurance requirements to be chosen as a default fund by employers.

If you're not an existing Cbus Super participating employer, go to our website to find out how to register and pay your employee super to Cbus.

To process employer superannuation contributions, Cbus Super needs certain employer information, including: **employer name, employer ABN, employer address, contact name and contact number.** Employer contributions must detail the period for which the contribution is made.
